• When should I turn in the fee waiver form?

*Provide it to the court with the petition.

Any tips for doing the fee waiver form?

*Be as detailed as you can on the accompanying declaration. Use approximations and averages if necessary. **Make sure you date and sign!!!**

- Order for turning in the forms to the courts, sex offender registry, etc:
 - 1. Petition (and fee waiver if applicable)
 - 2. Send out SOR w/case number and judge name
 - 3. Gather and file letters
 - 4. Request for Hearing
 - 5. Notice of Hearing (if applicable)
 - File proposed findings and order *note—some judges will request these pre-hearing, if so, their clerk will let you know

Post-Hearing: pick up certified copies

What needs to be submitted together?

See above #1 & #6

How to submit the information:

Most courts are still doing filings via email. Call your particular court and ask.
